How To Enter:

1. Send completed entry blank and \$20.00 check or money order to Stars Of Tomorrow Junior Championship, c/o M.C.B.O.A., 3960 Johnsborg Rd., Johnsborg, IL 60051. Please make checks payable to M.C.B.O.A. **Incomplete entry forms will not be accepted.** All entrants **must be a certified member of a McHenry County Youth League** in the following bowling centers: **Bowl-Hi, Brunswick Zone-Algonquin Rd., Crystal Bowl, Edgetown Bowl, McHenry Recreation, McGarry's Bowl, Raymond's Bowl, 3-D Bowl, Waynes Lanes or Westlanes Family Bowl.**
2. Bowlers averages will be as of February, 20, 2010. Entrant must use highest league average if bowling in multiple leagues. Averages must be of at least 12 games. Falsification of any of this information will lead to disqualification with forfeiture of entry fee.
3. All entries **MAILED WITHOUT** a \$20.00 check/money order entry fee will be considered a walk-in and will be subject to lane availability. All mailed entries with entry fee and complete entry form are reserved. Some squads will have limited lanes. The tournament director will try to accommodate squad preference on a first come, first served basis until the squad is full.
4. Entry fee breakdown; \$9.00 Expenses, \$11.00 prize fund.

Tournament Format/Rules:

1. This is a U.S.B.C. certified tournament.
2. Bowlers in both (age as of 8/1/09) divisions will bowl three games of qualifying on the same pair of lanes on qualifying squads on March 7th, 2010. Reentries are allowed. The four bowlers in each division with the most pins over their average for their three games (Over their "Target Score") will qualify for the Scholarship Finals which will take place immediately following the final qualifying squad for BOTH divisions. Only the highest score an entrant has will be considered in the case of re-entry. Re-entry fee is \$20.00.
3. All bowlers who qualify for the finals and are not present for the finals check-in will forfeit the place and be moved to the bottom of the cashing list. The fifth place bowler (alternate) will be allowed to bowl in the finals as the 4th seed, regardless of the place of the missing finalist. The four finalists will bowl in a "TV finals step-ladder format" to determine a Champion and scholarship winners.
4. Guaranteed prizes will be increased if entries warrant as determined by the Tournament Director.
5. Swearing, unsportsmanlike conduct, or abuse of bowling center equipment will result in immediate disqualification, with forfeiture of entry fee. All rulings/decisions made by the tournament director are final.
6. Tournament director reserves the right to re-rate any bowler.
7. Scholarships will be held by USBC-SMART scholarship management program, Account #8768.
8. No cell phones, I-pod-MP3 or other electronics allowed in setee area.
9. **DRESS CODE:** All bowlers may wear the USBC Youth Jersey, a youth league issued shirt, or a collared shirt. No hats or headwear will be allowed while bowling. No shorts, cutoffs, sweatpants, jogging pants, or ripped denim allowed. All dress code decisions made by the Tournament Director are final.
