BAKER TEAM SHOOTOUT VI March 13, 2010 Raymond's Bowl

Baker Bowling: All five team members contribute 2 frames each for one game of bowling. One bowler will bowl the 1st and 6th frames, another the 2nd and 7th, another the 3rd and 8th, etc.

Format:

16 Baker Games of Round – Robin Match Play. The winning team of each game will earn 30 bonus pins. Ties award 15 pins each. Following qualifying, top 4 teams seeded based on qualifying position into single elimination bracket finals. All finals matches will be best of 3 game matches.

Only 5 person roster. Order of bowlers may be switched upon the completion of any game. No substitutions.

Ties:
Tie for seed position will be broken by awarding the team with the highest single game earning the higher seed. If tie still exists, coin flip will determine higher seed. Ties in finals games will be scored as a .5 game to each team. 1.5 to 1.5 ties in bracket matches will bowl a tie-breaker game.

Entry Fee:

Entry Fee: \$250.00, (\$50.00 per bowler x 5). \$187.50 Prize Fund, \$62.50 Lineage and Tournament Expenses. All Prize Money Awarded 100%.

Rules:

1. Tournament is certified by the USBC.
2. Tournament is open to USBC members only.
3. Entries close at 12:00 PM Sunday, March 13, 2010 or when filled. This is a one day only event.
4. Each participant may enter only once. Entry fees must be paid in full with completed entry blank to hold spot.
5. Use highest 2008-2009 sanctioned/certified book average of 45 games or more bowled. If you do not have a 2008-2009 average, use current certified high league average as of March 6, 2010 of 21 or more games. Those without a verifiable average in accordance with above rules are excluded. Verification of your average is required before you bowl. Tournament officials reserve the right to refuse any average or bowler and have the right to rerate any bowler. If the rerated average is not accepted by the bowler, the entry fee shall be refunded before bowling. Summer league averages will not be accepted.
- 5a. USBC Rule 319d, tournament prize winnings provision applies (\$600.00 or more).
- 5b. Per USBC rule 319e, if bowlers' tournament average is 15 pins higher than entering average bowler must submit this average to tournament officials for possible re-rating.
- 5c. Averages from USBC Sport Leagues will not be accepted.
6. Maximum team entering average is 1100.
7. **Team handicap will be based on 80% of 1100.**
8. Any bowler falsifying average information will forfeit all prize money due.
9. USBC rule 319c requirement for average rerate will apply to all entrants.
10. Failure to use correct average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than correct average thereby resulting in more handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average. However, corrections in averages may be permitted up to the completion of the first game.
11. Prize list is based on 16 team entries.
12. All prize money will be returned 100%. One in four entries will cash. Prize list will be pro-rated if less than 16 teams.
13. Bowlers are required to check-in at 11:30am.
14. So as to not delay payouts of prize list, bowlers should bring a league average verification from their league secretary. Any dispute in scoring shall be brought to the attention of the tournament official immediately. All USBC rules will apply.
15. All team prizes will be distributed to the team captain. Captain is responsible for distributing prize money to individual team members.
